
Sample size	2,412 interviews with Ethiopian adults











Do you have any family members or relatives living in another country outside Ethiopia?



















14% of Ethiopian adults are regular remittance recipients



How frequently does your family member or relative send you money?










How much money – on average – does your family member or relative send to you each time?










